FAA PUBLISHES DRAFT AC 150/5300-13A, AIRPORT DESIGN

Today, the FAA published a <u>notice</u> in the Federal Register regarding an opportunity to comment on the draft <u>Advisory Circular (AC) 150/5300-13A</u>, <u>Airport Design</u>. The FAA invites airport consultants, industry representatives and all other interested parties to review and comment on the draft AC 150/5300-13A. The AC provides standards and recommendations for airport design. AC 150/5300-13A was substantially revised to fully incorporate all previous changes to AC 150/5300-13, as well as new standards and technical requirements.

The draft of AC 150/5300-13A includes the following significant changes: (1) an introduction of the Runway Reference Code (RRC) and the Runway Design Code (RDC); (2) an expanded discussion on Declared Distances; (3) a clarified discussion on the Runway Protection Zone (RPZ); (4) the introduction of a Taxiway Design Group (TDG) concept for fillet design; (5) the establishment of better guidelines for separation between non-intersecting runways and intersecting runways; (6) the inclusion of Runway Incursion prevention geometry for taxiway to runway interface; and (7) the consolidation of numerous design tables into one Runway Design Standards Matrix.
