## FAA EXTENDS COMMENT DEADLINE FOR DRAFT WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT GUIDANCE

The FAA Office of Airport Safety and Standards (AAS-300) has extended the comment period on the following draft Advisory Circulars (AC), which address different aspects of wildlife management for airports:

- <u>Draft AC 150/5200-32B</u>, Reporting Wildlife Aircraft Strikes
- <u>Draft AC 150/5200-33C</u>, Hazardous Wildlife Attractants On or Near Airports
- <u>Draft AC 150/5200-XX</u>, Protocol for the Conduct and Review of Wildlife Hazard Site Visits, Wildlife Hazard Assessments, and Wildlife Hazard Management Plans

The draft ACs are discussed in greater detail in the McBreen & Kopko <u>December 2012 Airport Services Newsletter</u>. Comments are now **due on or before January 31, 2012**.
